3. Any efforts that help clean up neighborhoods, parks, trails, wooded areas, wetlands, etc. may be counted provided there is adult supervision and the appropriate authorities have been notified.

5. Students may do service projects through an agency such as:
 - Boy or Girl Scouts
 - Red Cross

 - Volunteering at the local library

 - Volunteering at an animal shelter.
