

THE UNIFORM IS A PART OF CROWN POINTE ACADEMY. WHEN MAKING THE CHOICE TO COME TO THIS SCHOOL, YOU ARE MAKING THE CHOICE TO ENDORSE, SUPPORT AND ABIDE BY THIS POLICY. THIS IS A PART OF YOUR PARENT CONTRACT.

Clothing Sources and Colors

All pieces, colors, and styles must resemble the Dennis Uniform Company. **However, all khaki uniform apparel except socks must be purchased from Dennis Uniform Company.** No embroidery, lace, or logos except the CPA logo is allowed. Oversized or baggy clothing is not acceptable.

The Director will have final interpretation and say on any item of this policy that is questionable.

Shirts/Blouses:

Shirts must be white or red in color.

Shirts may be long or short sleeved and may be oxford point or cotton point collar, polo or turtleneck, or plain collared blouses.

T-shirts worn under shirts or blouses must be solid white, T-shirt material.

All shirts must be worn tucked in at all times.

Mesh shirts, tight fitting shirts, spaghetti straps, or ¾ length or elbow shirts are not allowed. Shirts with lace will not be allowed.

Tiny scalloped trim (picot) on the edge of girl's polo shirts will be allowed.

Ribbed & mock turtlenecks are not allowed.

At least one button of the polo shirt must be buttoned.

Pants:

Boys: Navy or Dennis khaki, Girls: Navy pants must be twill dress style pants, resembling the Dennis uniform style.

Topstitching along side seams and denim-type or knit fabrics is not acceptable.

No loose fitting, baggy, wide leg or bell-bottoms will be allowed. Pants should have straight legs. No corduroy, cargo style, carpenter style, sweat pants, or labels (except Dennis) on the outside of pants are allowed.

If pants are purchased with a label on the outside, please remove before wearing.

Shorts:

Boys: Navy or Dennis khaki, Girls: Navy or MacBeth plaid

Shorts must be twill, walking shorts. The style must resemble the Dennis uniform style.

No corduroy, cargo style, carpenter style, labels (except Dennis) on the outside of shorts.

If the shorts are purchased with a label, other than Dennis, on the outside, please remove before wearing.

Shorts length must be no shorter than mid-thigh.

Tight shorts are not allowed except when worn under skirts or jumpers.

Dresses:

Girls: Navy or MacBeth plaid
Plain jumpers, skirts or culottes/skorts with no visible, chains, or similar trim are allowed.
Buttons should be the same color as the fabric.
Jumper, skirt, and culottes/skorts are not to be higher than the end of the fingertips with arm fully extended at the sides.
Shorts must be worn under jumpers and skirts on gym days.

Shoes:

Styles must be tennis shoes or sneakers, dress shoes, sandals or clogs with back strap, cowboy boots or hiking boots.
Acceptable colors are white, black, brown, navy, gray, or cordovan.
Tennis shoes must compliment the uniform and be as plain as possible. The primary color of the shoe must be one of the above colors.
No roller shoes with or without rollers may be worn at any time.
The base of the heel must be the width of the shoe and the height must be less than 2 inches. Glitter, character, or light up shoes may not be worn.
Boots intended for outside wear (snow boots) may not be worn in the classroom.
Activity appropriate shoes must be worn; for example, no clogs during PE class.
Socks and or tights must be worn with all shoe selections at all times.

Belts:

Belts are mandatory for grades 4-8. Approved colors are black, brown, tan, cordovan or navy.
The width of the belt will be no wider than 1½ inches.
The belt should be plain, one color, with no metal other than the buckle.

Accessories:

Accessories must be MacBeth plaid colors (navy, black, red, white, yellow, dark green) or MacBeth plaid.
Excessive accessories that detract from the learning environment process will not be allowed.
Solid red or navy ties may be worn.

Jewelry:

Necklaces may not be worn unless they are under the shirt and cannot be seen.
Bracelets except for medical purposes may not be worn.
Watches are acceptable.

Socks/Tights:

Socks may be white, black, navy, red or khaki solid socks. Khaki socks do not need to be purchased from the Dennis Uniform Store.
Stripes or brand name logos are not allowed.
Lace and small scalloped trim (picot) must match the color of the socks.
Socks must be long enough to cover the anklebone.

Sweaters/sweater vests:

Colors may be solid red, navy, black, white or “MacBeth” plaid.
Styles may be plain v-neck or cardigan sweaters.
Cable sweaters are allowed if the sweater is a solid color.
No logos, trim, sequins, lace or embroidery, etc. are allowed.
Zippers and buttons must be the same color as the sweater.
Hoods are not allowed.
Tech vests, quilted vests, and vests with piping are not allowed.
Fleece clothing of any kind may not be worn in the classroom.
A uniform shirt with the collar or turtleneck showing must be worn under sweaters and vests.

Sweatshirts:

Only the Crown Pointe Academy navy or red sweatshirt is allowed.
A uniform shirt with the collar or turtleneck showing must be worn under sweatshirts.

Undergarments:

Care needs to be taken in the wearing of appropriate undergarments.
Wearing colored undergarments under a light shirt is not allowed.
Undershirts must be solid white T-shirt fabric.

Body Piercing:

No visible body piercing ornaments will be allowed, including tongue, nose, chin, eyebrow, or lip rings/studs. One earring in each ear will be allowed. Size of earring subject to safety.

Hair:

Hair must be neat and properly maintained, not disruptive to the learning environment.
No extreme fads, gang-related haircuts, hairnets nor hair stenciling is allowed.
No unnatural hair coloring, such as green or orange is allowed.

Cosmetics:

No cosmetics will be worn by elementary students.
Included is face glitter, colored lip-gloss or colored Chap Stick type products. If these products are brought to school, they will be taken and not returned.
(Clear Chap Stick will be allowed at the classroom teachers’ discretion)

Outdoor Clothing:

Weather appropriate, outdoor clothing may be worn over the uniform and must be removed upon entering the school building.
Hats and jackets may not be worn inside the school building.

Other items

Press-on artificial fingernails are not allowed.
Nail length and color may not interfere with safety or learning.

Grades 6-8 only - Additions to Uniform Policy for upper grades only

(All clothing restrictions listed on prior pages apply.)

Girls:

Dennis khaki shorts, skirts, pants, skirts, skorts/culottes with no visible chains or similar trim
navy shirts
denim shirt with the Crown Pointe Academy logo

Boys:

navy shirts
denim shirts with the Crown Pointe Academy logo

Cosmetics:

Cosmetics must be conservative and in good taste.

Gym Uniform:

A uniform will be worn for Physical Education. This uniform will be solid black shorts and solid gray T-shirts. Gym uniforms are to be purchased from the office. Plain dark navy or black sweat pants or warm-up pants may be worn if going outside on cold days.

ALL JACKETS AND OTHER OUTDOOR CLOTHING MUST BE KEPT IN THE LOCKER WHEN NOT OUTSIDE. CLOTHING WITH THE STUDENT IN CLASS OR IN THE HALLWAY THAT IS NOT PART OF THE UNIFORM POLICY WILL BE CONSIDERED A UNIFORM VIOLATION.

Dress Code For Non-Uniform Days

The questions of appropriateness of an item will be at the discretion of the Director. If clothing is deemed unsuitable, the student will call home and parent/guardian will have to bring a change of clothing for the child before he/she can go to class.

Clothing is not to cause undue attention to itself or the person wearing it.

Clothing is not to be distracting to the wearer or others around him/her.

Anything that causes or has the potential to cause embarrassment, derisive, or derogatory comments will not be allowed.

Excessively baggy clothing, inappropriate graphics or text on clothing are not allowed.

Shirts -No mesh or muscle, tight fitting, tube, half or halter tops, or see through shirts, blouses, or over shirts.

No spaghetti straps. Tank top straps must be at least 3 finger widths.

Pants -No undergarments should be visible.

Shorts, Skirts, Skorts -Length to ends of fingertips with arms extended.
No cutoffs or spandex shorts.

Shoes/Socks -Socks, tights, or hose must be worn at all times. Shoes must have backs or straps.

Undergarments -None should be visible.

Body Piercing -No visible body piercing ornaments will be allowed, including tongue, nose, chin, eyebrow, or lip rings/studs. One earring in each ear will be allowed. Size of earring subject to safety.

Hair -Hair must be neat and properly maintained, not disruptive to the learning environment. No extreme fads, gang-related haircuts, hair nets, or stenciling is allowed. No unnatural hair coloring such as green or orange.

Cosmetics -Must be conservative and in good taste.

Skin -No bellies, backs, buttocks, or cleavage should be visible.
