

Crown Pointe Academy's goal is to provide a secure school climate, conducive to teaching and learning that is free from threat, harassment and any type of bullying behavior by having Bullying Prevention and Education at all levels in the school. The purpose of this policy is to promote consistency of approach and to help create a climate in which all types of bullying are regarded as unacceptable.

Bullying is the use of coercion to obtain control over another person or to be habitually cruel to another person. Bullying can occur through written, verbal or electronically transmitted expression or by means of a physical act or gesture. Bullying is prohibited on Crown Pointe Academy or Colorado Charter School Institute property, at Crown Pointe Academy-sanctioned activities and events or Colorado Charter School Institute-sanctioned activities and events, when students are being transported in any vehicle dispatched by Crown Pointe Academy or Colorado Charter School Institute, or off Crown Pointe Academy or Colorado Charter School Institute property when such conduct has a nexus to Crown Pointe Academy or Colorado Charter School Institute curricular or non-curricular activity or event.
