

Crown Pointe Academy believes that the education of each student is a shared responsibility of the school and the parents/guardians. Crown Pointe Academy recognizes the need for a constructive partnership between the school and parents/guardians that provides for two-way communication and fosters educational support for students and parents/guardians.

It is Crown Pointe Academy's intent to cultivate and support active parental involvement and to set goals for parent-supported student learning by employing the following principles:

1. Encouraging parents to share in school planning and objective setting through participating in the school's accountability committees.
2. Helping parents understand the educational process and their role in supporting student achievement.
3. Informing parents of school choices within the home district, including but not limited to, information on open enrollment, choice programs, and charter school options.
4. Providing opportunities for parents/guardians to be informed about their student's progress toward attaining proficiency on state and Institute content standards through written materials and public meetings. Information shall explain how the student's progress will be measured and how parents will be informed of such progress. This information shall be provided to the school and Institute accountability committees.
5. Providing appropriate avenues for parents to find support in their role.
6. If the school must adopt an improvement, priority, or turnaround plan, parents/guardians must be informed within 30 days and shall hold a public meeting for parents/guardians to provide information and receive feedback.
