

The goal of Crown Pointe Academy is that all students will perform at proficient or better (or their equivalent terminology, as amended from time to time by the State) on all State of Colorado assessment testing required by the Colorado Department of Education.

In addition to administering the State of Colorado assessment test, the School will administer the assessments described below.

All students enrolled for one continuous academic year (August through May or June), except academically at-risk students, English language learners, and special education students, will demonstrate a minimum growth of one grade level per year in each subject/content area as measured by the following assessments:

- Grade K        A national standardized test,  
                  A test to determine the level the student is at in the Accelerated Readers Program (AR)
  
- Grades 1-8    Writing Assessment (given at the end of each school year, given to new students at the beginning of their 1<sup>st</sup> school year),  
                  AR testing once a year, and national standardized test 4 times per year.  
                  The test packet will include spelling and vocabulary.

All academically at-risk students (2 or more years behind in the core academic subjects, reading, writing and/or mathematics) enrolled for one continuous academic year (August through May or June), will achieve 1 and 1/2 year's academic growth each school year as measured by the Colorado Assessment tests, along with other bench mark testing.

All English language learners and special education students will achieve academic growth according to their individual learning or education plans.

Students are expected to show continuous growth in physical education, foreign languages, art, technology and music as measured by specific content standards attainment.

A Personalized Education Plan (PEP) will be developed for each student incorporating parent, student and teacher input and used to assist with individualized learning.

A student portfolio will be developed for each student, which will serve as a repository for classroom samples of students' work and assessments.
