

Elective Selection 2018-2019

Students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grades have one elective choice each year. Electives are held for 30 minutes every day for one semester. Students will take a specials class (art, music, physical education, or Expo) during the semester they are not enrolled in their electives class.

Please read the descriptions of the elective options below, and help your students select his/her elective class for next year. Please mark your selection on the back of this paper and return it to the school office as soon as possible. To ensure students have optimal access to equipment and technology for these classes, **electives will be filled on a first come, first served basis and will be capped at 27 students.**

1st Semester: Drama Instructor: Mrs. Southern

The Drama elective provides students with instruction and practice regarding the basic acting and drama principles including voice, movement, and character. Students will have the opportunity to both create and perform dramatic works of various lengths. Additionally, students will learn about technical aspects of theater including lighting, sound, set design, costumes, and props. Our culminating activity will be an in-class performance of a short play or scene.

2nd Semester: Foundations for Life Instructor: Mrs. Southern

This class is designed to give students exposure to basic skills through hands on experiences in order to help them become well-rounded and independent individuals. Students will participate in the following topics through a variety of activities including: hands on interaction, technology, research, as well as an opportunity for some creative expression.
