

It is the expectation of the Board that by February the Director will annually develop a calendar for final adoption for the upcoming school year.

The school calendar should reflect no less than 160 days as specified in state law unless annually requested by the school and approved by the state.

The school calendar shall include the dates for all professional development programs scheduled for the upcoming school year.

A copy of the calendar shall be available to all parents/guardians of students enrolled in Crown Pointe Academy.

Any change in the calendar, excluding emergency closings or other unforeseen circumstances, shall be preceded by adequate and timely notice. Each time a calendar is amended, an updated copy shall be submitted to CSI.

For the 2020-21 academic year, student contact days may include remote learning days implemented as a result of public health and safety measures.

If the school is closed due to an emergency or other unforeseen circumstance which results in student-teacher contact time being reduced below the minimum hours/minutes allowed by state law and provided for in the calendar, the Director shall adjust the calendar to make up for the lost time. Notification by email shall be made to the Charter School Institute on the dates that the school closed and include the planned make-up dates.
