Dear Crown Pointe Academy Parents and Guardians,

I hope you are having a wonderful summer! The start of school is just around the corner, and we can't wait for more growth and fun in the 2023-2024 school year.

Back to School Night will be on Tuesday, August 15th at 6:30 p.m. We are excited to welcome all families back to school to meet our amazing staff, visit the classrooms, and hear about the ways the school and family will work together this year. The schedule is as follows:

Back to School Welcome in the Gymnasium: 6:30-6:55

Elementary Classroom Sessions: 7:00-7:25 Session #1, 7:30-7:55 Session #2

Middle School Classroom Sessions: 7:00-7:10 Session #1, 7:15-7:25 Session #2, 7:30-7:40 Session #3,

7:45-7:55 Session #4

Elementary students will have testing by appointment on Monday, August 14th or Tuesday, August 15th and testing will take approximately <u>1 HOUR</u>. Please see the enclosed testing information and note that attendance at these testing appointments is mandatory. <u>Please bring your student's school supplies to your testing appointment</u>. **Elementary students' first full day of school is Wednesday, August 16th.**

Full school begins for **middle school students** on Monday, August 14th. Middle school students will have the opportunity to drop off their school supplies and pick up their class schedules and locker combinations on Wednesday, August 9th from 4:00-6:00 and Friday, August 11th from 2:00-4:00. These will also be times for middle school students to set up their lockers and practice their combinations. **We encourage all middle school students to drop off their supplies on one of these two days** because regular classes will start on Monday, August 14th at 8:00 a.m., and there will be very limited time for locker set up and supply drop off.

Please pay your school fees for the year no later than Friday, August 4th. The following is a list of fees for the 2023-2024 school year:

- Specials/classroom/field trip/technology fees for all students in all grades \$85.00. This fee is used for specials (art, music, P.E., etc.) supplies, additional supplies for your child's classroom in addition to the supply list, classroom consumables, pencils and erasers, school-issued technology, and this also helps to defray the cost of field trips and field trip transportation. We will continue to work with our school budget to keep fees as low as possible.
- Locker fee for all middle school students- \$10.00. The Middle School locker fee must be paid and the agreement signed by the student before the locker combination will be distributed.
- Middle School Beginning Band fee- \$30.00. This fee is for middle school students who select Beginning Band as their elective class for the year.
- Jeans (Optional)- \$30.00 per child for the entire year on Fridays and some other special days throughout the year.

How do you pay your fees for the year? CPA uses CheddarUp.com to collect payments online using a credit card, or you may still pay with cash or check at the school. If you wish to pay fees online, there is a 3.5% + \$0.59 processing fee for a credit card. To complete **online** payment for beginning of year fees, visit www.crownpointeacademy.org. Select the **Registration Fees Credit Card Payment** link under the Parents tab of

the website. Select the fees and quantities you would like to pay, and select Continue. You can then check out as a guest or create an account. Contact Sandi MacGregor in the office with any questions.

School supply lists are on the Crown Pointe website (www.crownpointe academy.org) or available at the school. Please bring your student's supplies to their testing appointment or to supply drop off. Because drop off is extra busy, please do NOT bring school supplies on the first day of school.

Jeans Day: If you would like for your child to wear jeans on Fridays and special days throughout the year, Jeans Day can be purchased for \$30.00 per child for the entire year. Payment must be received by October 1st. **The week-by-week option is not available.** All funds raised go to the 8th Grade Spanish Trip program. Any family who purchases jeans for the year will be given a 20 hour credit for two parent households and a 10 hour credit for single parent households towards your volunteer commitment hours for the year.

School Store: The Crown Pointe Academy school store is ready to provide you with all of your CPA gear! Please visit www.crownpointeacademy.org and select the School Store tab from the menu. This will direct you to the School Store page where you can order and purchase many Crown Pointe Academy products. Please see the CPA Uniform Policy for details on what can be worn during the week and pay special attention to the uniform basics and rules regarding hair style and color prior to the start of school. Remember that hair must be a natural color and stenciling is NOT allowed. Thank you for your support of this policy!

Breakfast and hot lunch will be offered through the Boulder Valley School District. Breakfast will be offered to all students in the classroom each morning. **Don't forget to complete your annual application for benefits by going to www.crownpointeacademy.org**, clicking on the Parents tab, and selecting the Free and Reduced Lunch **Application.** While all meals will be free in the coming school year, it is important that families complete the annual application for additional benefits such as P-EBT as well as qualifying CPA for additional funding and grants.
